Inside Former Boyers Department Store

Omega undertook a project in the heart of Ireland, Dublin on the active North Earl Street. The task was to carry out the safe removal and disposal of asbestos in various forms from various locations. The value of the project was £60,000 and had an estimated duration of 4 weeks. This is including weekend working to cater for the retailers needs to re-open as soon as possible to lessen any trading loss. Thanks to the hard work and expertise knowledge provided by Omega personnel the project was successfully completed 1 week ahead of schedule.

The scope of work carried out includes; the safe removal and disposal of pipe lagging insulation, AIB panels, roof slates and floor tiles.

Pre-work checks were conducted to ensure a safe operating environment for our operatives. These checks include appropriate isolation arrangements, a reassurance air test, double check all areas around enclosure are clean and seal and to set up exclusion zones, barriers and signage are all set up to provide safety to pedestrians. The size of this project called for careful planning and regular meetings with the client to confirm that the project is running smoothly.

The former police headquarters in Winchester is a 7 floor tower block containing asbestos insulation boards situated in various locations throughout the building. This job was valued at £150,000 and had a time frame of 2 months to be completed.
