Description of work

Omega Environmental was appointed by the University of Bath to undertake asbestos removal works to facilitate the total refurbishment of the block. An asbestos risk assessment of Building 1 West identified the presence of asbestos containing materials (ACMs) in the structure. Omega Environmental remit was the removal of these ACMs from the building.

A key element of the project was the removal of all ACMs and a full environmental clean prior to the refurbishment work:

- Removal of asbestos sprayed insulation to all steelwork
- Removal of all internal block, brick and plasterboard walls
- Removal of insulation board column cladding and fillets
