Description of work

Sabic, based in Riyadh, is the largest public company in Saudi Arabia. The company works on the principle that safety is no accident and we must believe that all accidents are preventable.

This complex project is divided across two complexes namely Aromatics 1 and 2 plants on the north east coast between Middlesbrough and Hartlepool.

Omega were working on the site under the direction of appointed Principal Contractor Thompsons of Prudhoe responsible for the overall decommissioning of the site. The site is highly regulated in terms of health and safety enforcement so it is vitally important that we skill matched our people to particular tasks with a pragmatic but thorough risk assessment thought process.

With up to 50 skilled Omega staff on site at any one time, the project is resourced with continual internal on-site health and safety support. Omega is tasked with the licensed asbestos removal work on both installations and will remain on site well into next year (2019).

In high hazardous sites it is vital that we maintain a highly skilled workforce and it is evident that our local team are actively engaged in regular site briefings and tool box talks. The project is supervised exceptionally well and there is very good site surveillance and monitoring of our works by third parties. On a weekly basis the site is subjected to an un-announced site safety audit by Omega's Health and Safety Manager, Tony Birchall.
